# STEP UP! After School Program

STEP UP! is designed to provide positive child development, allowing students to achieve academic, personal, family, and social goals through the STEP UP! key words. The program operates on school days from dismissal to 6pm. Students are required to attend each day for the duration of the program and to be signed out daily. LAUSD's Food Services Branch provides nutritional snacks for all students enrolled in the program. We maintain a 20:1 student to adult ratio to ensure proper supervision and a safe environment. Our staff is youth oriented, caring, ethnically diverse & are great role models for our students.
